Damage Policy

Parents are liable for damage to Dartmouth Yacht Club boats and/or equipment if it can be shown that the student disregarded instructions and the loss was a result of direct negligence – i.e. Not securing a rudder properly and the rudder is subsequently lost.

In the event of direct negligence, the club will pay 40% of the damages and the other boat involved will be responsible for 60% of the damages. If two or more boats are involved, the 60% will be divided equally. In each boat, the skipper of the boat is responsible for 60% of his/her share of the damages. While the crew is responsible for 40% of his/her share of damages.

Junior Sailing Student Instructions

The following rules are designed for your safety and will be enforced:

1. PFDs must be worn at all times while in a boat or on a dock.
2. Soft sole shoes must be worn at all times on boats.
3. The instructors' instructions must be carried out immediately.
4. Horseplay (instructors' discretion) will not be permitted while under instruction.
5. Written permission from a parent/guardian is required for a student to leave the DYC premises during program hours.
6. Discipline will be maintained as required. Failure of a student to abide by the instructions of the instructor may result in the following:
 - i. First offence: suspension for remainder of the day
 - ii. Second offence: suspension for one full day
 - iii. Third offence: suspension for one week
 - iv. Fourth offence: removal from the course.

No refund of fees will be offered in any case of suspension.
